

Questions on Colossians 4:2-6

Read Colossians 4:2-4 and discuss any item of interest that arises from the passage.

1. How important do you think a regular “quiet time”, ie time spent by yourself in bible reading and prayer, is for a person’s spiritual growth?
2. How important is regular corporate prayer, ie prayer with a group of other Christians, is for a person’s spiritual growth?
3. Share with the group your practice of private devotion if you want to.
4. Do you take advantage of opportunities for corporate prayer?
5. What difficulties do you encounter in having a regular “quiet time”?
6. What distractions come your way during such times?
7. How might you counter such issues?

Read Colossians 4:5-6 and discuss any item of interest that arises from the passage.

8. What sort of “walk towards outsiders” would regard as foolish, and what you regard as wise.
9. Have you been tempted to talk less than graciously with or about outsiders?
10. Controlling one’s tongue is difficult (James 3:7-10). What advice do you have for speaking graciously?
