- 1. How important do you think a regular "quiet time", ie time spent by yourself in bible reading and prayer, is for a person's spiritual growth?
- 2. How important is regular corporate prayer, ie prayer with a group of other Christians, is for a person's spiritual growth?
- 3. Share with the group your practice of private devotion if you want to.
- 4. Do you take advantage of opportunities for corporate prayer?
- 5. What difficulties do you encounter in having a regular "quiet time"?
- 6. What distractions come your way during such times?
- 7. How might you counter such issues?

Read Colossians 4:5-6 and discuss any item of interest that arises from the passage.

- 8. What sort of "walk towards outsiders" would regard as foolish, and what you regard as wise.
- 9. Have you been tempted to talk less than graciously with or about outsiders?
- 10. Controlling one's tongue is difficult (James 3:7-10). What advice do you have for speaking graciously?
