 - a. What would it look like for us to have this "great faith" today? (give practical examples)

- 7) Why is the woman's loss a double blow?

- 8) How does v13 show us what Jesus' heart is like? How does that make you feel?

Bonus Question: What makes this miracle unique? (Jesus raises the son without anyone asking him to)

Bonus Question: Read 1 Kings 17:24 & 2 Kings 4:32-37. How are these accounts similar and different to Jesus' healing here?

- 9) How do these two passages encourage us to have faith in Jesus?

- 10) How is Luke 7:1-17 good news for your non-Christian friend/family member?
