- 4. How can we avoid the same spiritual decline as the church in Ephesus?

Thyatira (Revelation 2:20-29)

- 1. What was the positive aspect of the church in Thyatira?
- 2. What was the negative aspect of the church in Thyatira?
- 3. What is the significance of the reference to Jezebel in Thyatira?
- 4. How can we avoid the spiritual dangers that plagued the church in Thyatira?

Laodicea (Revelation 3:14-22)

- 1. What was the lukewarm situation of the church in Laodicea?
- 2. Why does Jesus say, "Would that you were either cold or hot!" How did this relate to the geographic setting of the church?
- 3. Why did Max say that the problem of the church was probaby not half-heartedness but self-deception?
- 4. How can we avoid the spiritual self-deception of the church in Laodicea?

- 2. What common themes or warnings can be found in these three letters?
- 3. How can these letters be applied to the Church today?
