1. What's the best invitation you've ever received and why?
2. Recap what we've heard so far in Rev?

Read Rev 19:1-10

3. What are the causes for the "Hallelujahs" (you may need to quickly recap Rev 18)
 - a. Vv1-3
 - b. Vv6-8
4. How does the picture of Christ's return as "the wedding of the Lamb" shape our expectation and excitement of his return? (see also Isa 25:6ff; Matt 22:1-14; Eph 5:21-33)
 - a. How do we prepare ourselves for this coming day in a way that doesn't undermine grace? (i.e. v7 *the bride has made herself ready*, v8 *fine linen stands for the righteous acts of God's holy people*)
5. What does it practically look like for our lives to be marked by these "Hallelujahs" now?

Bonus Question: How does Rev 19:10 help us have a right perspective of angels?

Read Rev 19:11-21

6. What stands out for you and why?
7. As a group (or as individuals or pairs) what are the qualities and actions of the Rider in vv11-16 and why are they significant?
8. For all the build-up of the Great Battle (esp in the OT and in Rev), why do you think we're not told about it in Rev 19?
9. How is vv17-21 both a grim warning and an encouragement to us?
10. How is Rev good news to our non-Christian contacts?
